

1. Enter your email address on the Bethere.co.nz website and be added to the BeThere.co.nz database between 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2010 – 28<sup>th</sup> February 2010 to be in the draw.
2. The prize consists of a double pass (two single entry tickets) to the Premiere Garden Party of the Ellerslie International Flower Show held on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> March 2010 from 4.30pm – 7.30pm. Prize is valued at \$250 and cannot be exchanged for cash or transferred.
